Local Field Directors, U.S. Sportsmen's Alliance representatives, attend each event to ensure coordination between all participating organizations.

The Trailblazer Adventure Program was designed to expose families to outdoor activities during the Trailblazer Adventure Day and offer them the chance to engage in the activities through the year-long Trailmaster mentoring program.
